Excursions and guided tours



SIGHTSEEING OF THE VILLAGE

A walk through the suggestive buildings of Pianosa village to get to know the history and habits of the communities that lived here, a historical path from the Stone Age to 19th-century settlements. Duration: 1 hour and 30 '. € 5, children 0-4 years free.



ARCHAEOLOGICAL TREKKING

Tour of the areas where important archaeological remains are preserved. From the Belvedere, the highest point of the island, we reach the remains of the Villa of Agrippa Postumo on the Cala Giovanna coast. Trekking shoes are required. Duration: 2 hours. € 10 adults, € 5 children 5-12 years, children 0-4 years free.



MOUNTAIN BIKE

The itinerary crosses the island and reaches Punta del Marchese, in the far north, overlooking the beautiful Porto Romano Bay. A helmet (provided by the Park Authority) and suitable shoes are required; indemnity obligation for minors who must be accompanied by an adult. Duration: 2 hours. Length: 11 km. € 15. Minimum age 12 years.



SNORKELING

Flippers, mask and snorkel to observe marine flora and fauna and admire a marine environment that has remained intact like only a protected area can be. Minors must be accompanied by at least one adult. Indemnity obligation for minors. Duration: 1 hour and 30' (about 50 minutes in water). Length: about 1 km. € 15. Minimum age 14 years.



SEA KAYAK (sit-on-top)

An extraordinary opportunity to navigate the waters of the protected area along the spectacular coasts and cliffs of the island. Indemnity obligation for minors who must be accompanied by an adult. It is mandatory to wear the safety equipment provided by the Park Authority. Duration: 2 hours. € 25. Minimum age 14 years.



PALAEONTOLOGICAL TREKKING

Itinerary leading from Cala S. Giovanni to Cala di Biagio Cave, where in the 19th century several prehistoric stone tools have been recovered, together with deer and bovid bones following recent excavations, which testify an ancient connection with the continent. Trekking shoes are required. Duration: 2 hours. € 10 adults, € 5 children 5-12 years, children 0-4 years free.



CARRIAGE GUIDED TOUR

A slow and gentle way to experience nature, the beauty and charm of the island. The hike crosses the branches of the former prison and Orti di Pianosa, with some stops for admiring the view. Duration: 1 hour and 15 ′. € 16 adults, € 13 children 5-12 years, children 0-4 years free.



BUS GUIDED TOUR

Comfortably seated on a bus along the lonely dirt roads of Pianosa to discover its nature and the ancient agricultural and prison history. Duration: 1 hour and 15 '. € 20 adult, € 14 reduced 5 - 12 years, children 0-4 years free.



SPECIAL ITINERARIES


Geological Geo-MTB (€ 20) and Geo-Trek in the southern area (€ 15) with an expert geologist. Activities are suitable people over 14 years of age. Indemnity obligation for minors. It is mandatory to wear a helmet (provided by the Park Authority) and trekking shoes.
